

## Submission Information

Please help **Artists Repertory Theatre** continue its policy of accepting queries from individual playwrights -- rather than requiring agent submissions as many other theaters do -- by complying with the following guidelines.

### We DO accept:

The first 10 pages of a script, in **professional format**. These must be accompanied by:

- A character breakdown, including number and gender of actors
- A complete synopsis
- An addressed postcard or stamped envelope for feedback (An email address is not sufficient)

### Optionally, you MAY include:

- A cover letter
- Your professional resumé
- Any articles, reviews, or recommendations
- A CD of songs, or sample lyrics, for a musical

### We do NOT accept:

- Full scripts, either printed or electronic, that have not been solicited by us
- Emails, phone calls, or mailings that describe plays or productions
- One-act plays, or others that run under 90 minutes

Submissions that do not conform to the above will be discarded unread.

### We are seeking:

Well-crafted, *full-length* plays of unexpected experiences; plays which expand hearts and minds. Challenge us with adventurous and provocative plays that resonate emotionally and explore the human condition. While there are no restrictions on style or subject matter, realism is preferred. We are often looking for small-cast shows, for **six or fewer actors**, with simple sets and minimal production requirements. This applies also to musicals, but please be aware that we produce original musicals infrequently. We will consider plays that have been produced elsewhere, but not as yet in the Portland area.
