ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Separate audition dates are held for Equity and non-Equity actors. Audition appointments are made on a first-come, first-served basis. When the appointments have been filled, the remaining actors are put on a waiting list and seen, if possible, on a time-available basis throughout the production season.

Please provide a headshot and a current resume. Present two contrasting monologues totaling no more than three minutes in length.

Additionally, Artists Repertory Theatre participates in the semi-annual general auditions organized by the Portland Area Theatre Alliance (PATA). These auditions are an important opportunity for Artists Rep's artistic staff to see and stay current with the work of local actors.

PRODUCTION CASTING

Artists Rep artistic staff, in consultation with directors, invites individual actors to read for roles in specific productions. These auditions are held throughout the year on an invitation-only basis.

Actors invited to audition will be provided with sides. Production scripts may be read on site.

For the audition, please provide a headshot and a current resume. (Even if Artists Rep has your resume on file, it is helpful for us to have an additional copy for the director of the production.)

OUT-OF-TOWN CASTING

Throughout the year, Equity actors visiting from out of town are welcome to request an audition appointment by calling the theatre: 503-241-9807 ext 110. Auditions are scheduled on a time-available basis.

MAINTAINING INFORMATION
